Baby Bees - Our Baby Bees children have been preparing for Halloween doing lots of fun activities and getting very creative with the arts and crafts.

Throughout the month Baby Bees have been focusing on different textures. All the children have been exploring the garden and looking at the different colours of the leaves and feeling them, exploring the textures. Lastly, we would like to say good bye to all our children who have transitioned to Honey Bees and we will miss you all so much.

Honey Bees - We would like to welcome all new children to our Honey Bees, they have all settled in well and have been fantastic. This month Honey Bees have been focusing on drawing and how we can make marks on the paper, sand, and shaving foam. We have even attached crayons to cars and pushed the cars across the paper and watched the different marks and colours they made. We have also been exploring the leaves in the garden feeling the textures and talking about the colours they were. We even brought them inside to paint and make leaf prints, we discussed them as a group. All the children enjoyed getting messy with the shaving foam making marks

using our fingers and sticks we found in the garden.

Bizzy Bees - Bizzy Bees children have been focusing on their letter recognition this month. We have been using letter flashcards in our phonics sessions and the children have been fantastic at recognising each letter. They have also been practicing their scissor control to make snips in the paper and attempting to cut out different shapes.

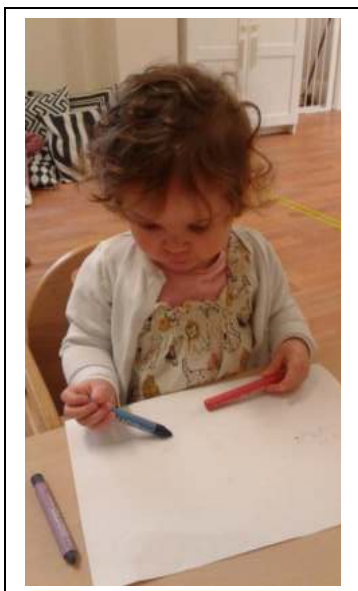
Staff
