Parents Notices

Reminder – Can you make sure you are wearing your mask when coming to the door, if anyone different is collecting, please make them aware too. If you are exempt, please let us know and we can add you to our exempt list. With the new variant spreading quickly, we need to keep all our staff and children safe. Thank you for your cooperation.

Reminder – Please do not put your child in open toe sandals for nursery as these are a tripping hazard when children are playing and running in the garden. Thank you.

Reminder – Can all parents please use smaller bags for their children's belongings and only bring in what is needed. In Baby Bees, we do have baskets for each child that can store their spare clothes etc. This is due to limiting space available to store big bags. Thank you.

Reminder – I have noticed more toys are being brought in from home. Can I ask if this is not a comforter then could your child leave their toys at home as we cannot take responsibility if these get lost or broken. Thank you.

Reminder – Parents wishing to leave car seats/bikes/prams are more than welcome to, we have a storage cupboard to the right of the nursery. This cupboard will be left unlocked of a morning and night for you to put them in and take them out. Thank you.

Reminder - Hopefully, this is the start of the nice weather so could I please ask if you all could bring in a labeled sun hat for your child while in the garden. We supply sun cream and will keep applying throughout the day. If you wish for your child to have their own sun cream, please bring in a new labeled bottle. Thank you.

Reminder – Do not bring your child in if they have been given paracetamol/Calpol/ibuprofen etc. Giving medication can mask a temperature. If your child has had a cough, they will need to get tested before coming into nursery and the negative result emailed to us. A cough is a symptom of Covid and we all want to reduce the spread and keep our children and staff in nursery. Thank you.
