Michaella Davies has worked for Bumbles since April 2021 and is currently working towards completing her Level 2 Childcare qualification.


Michaella works within our Honey Bees Room as a permanent member of staff where she has developed amazing bonds with the children.

Parent Reminders / Information

Just a reminder to all parents/ carers, we are aware that we are now going into that time of year that children do get cough's and cold's but Covid 19 is still very much around so please be vigilant to help keep everyone safe. A cough and a high temperature are still symptoms of Coronavirus and following Government Guidelines if your child has any of these symptoms they will still need a PCR test to rule out Covid-19. If the test comes back as negative and it has been 48 hours since your child's last temperature they are fine to come back into Nursery. However if you decide to not get your child tested they must stay off nursery and isolate for 10 days. Also another reminder, we can only give paracetamol for a high temperature. We thank you for your understanding and cooperation in this matter.

They also made beautiful leaf college pictures using glue and paper leaves.








Bizzy Bees 👘








Partnership with Parents
