#### Events this month

1/3/22 Shrove Tuesday - The children will be learning the Pancake Song. This will encourage children to recognise how many pancakes there are and help support children in counting and explore 'one more' or 'one less' by singing the song 'to buy a pancake and take it away'. The children will also enjoy participating in making pancakes and tasting them.



The children will also be making animal face pancakes with different fruit as it allows them to understand the basic concepts of early maths and science.

Children will be able to explore new and different food groups, but it will also help to develop their confidence, problem solving, teamwork, hand-eye coordination and communication skills.



1/3/22 St David's Day - The children will be celebrating this day by creating their own daffodil pictures and learning all about St David's Day. See if you can spot our Welsh flag flying outside our nursery on this day!



3/3/22 The Children will be celebrating 25 years of World Book Day where the children and staff can dress up as their favourite book character and share lots of stories.



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4/3/22 -13/3/22 - Winter Paralympics - The Winter Paralympics is taking place in Beijing. As it is all about the taking part that counts the children will take part in their own races, crafting their own medals and talking about the different sports that Olympians take part in.



17/3/22 St Patricks Day - The children will be celebrating this day by making Leprechauns with pots of gold, making Shamrocks and much more. See if you can spot our Irish flag flying outside our nursery on this day!



18/3/22 Red Nose Day - The nursery will be celebrating this day by wearing something red and we ask if you could make a small donation of £1. We will be holding a cake sale, made up of cakes made and baked by the children. All money raised will go towards the Comic Relief appeal and our defibrillator fund.


