Parents Information

Did you know you could be eligible to claim Tax Free Childcare? The government will pay up to £2000 per year per child (aged 11 years and under). This could be as high as £4000 per year per child if you already claim DLA.

Research has shown that 75% of eligible families are not using Tax Free Childcare. It only takes about 20 minutes to check your eligibility and apply. Basically, for every £8 you pay into an online account, the government will add an extra £2. It is worth 20 minutes of your time to check your eligibility! Also, when in the playrooms, can all parents/carers enter the room fully making sure the playroom door is shut behind them. Can all Bizzy Bee parents/carers make sure the stair gates are closed and bolted when entering or exiting.

For red nose day the Honey Bees children painted red nose pictures using cotton wool bubs and getting messy with red paint having so much fun.






Bizzy Bees

For Red Nose Day the Bizzy Bees children made cakes for our cake sale and wore red.








A massive thank you to everyone who donated for Red Nose Day, we made £56.50!
