

BABY BEES

This month, we have been focusing on developing our mark making skills. The children have had lots of fun exploring the different ways we can make marks. Also exploring the materials we can use to create them. They used their fine motor skills to make different marks with chalk and in sand. PARENT/CARER INFORMATION

Did you know you could be eligible to claim Tax Free Childcare? The government will pay up to £2,000 per year per child (aged 11 years and under). This could be as high as £4,000 per year per child if you already claim DLA.

Research has shown that 75% of eligible families are not using Tax Free Childcare. It only takes about 20 minutes to check your eligibility and apply. Basically for every £8 you pay into an online account, the government will add an extra £2. It is definitely worth 20 minutes of your time to check your eligibility!
