31/05/22 -1/06/22 Queen's Jubilee - We are celebrating the Queen's Jubilee with various activities such as making crowns, flags, wearing red, white and blue and exploring in our tuff tray with various sensory activities.

05/06/22 World Environment Day - It is very important that our children understand their responsibility when it comes to looking after our planet, as we are an eco-school, we will be getting our children to draw pictures of flowers and plants they may find in our garden. News from around the rooms...

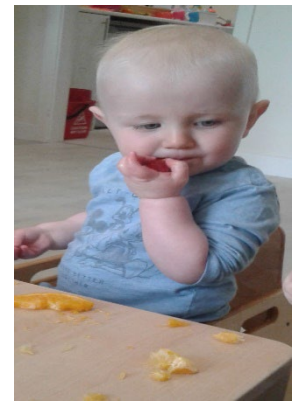
Baby Bees
