Parents Notice

We will be introducing our garden collection from 1st July. To the left of the front door is a sign that says, 'Please collect your child from the garden', if your child's room is on that sign (this will be a coloured handprint that will say either Baby Bees, Honey Bees or Bizzy Bees on), please go to your right and follow the building round to the back gate, ring the bell and a member of staff will let you in. The same rules will apply that only one parent is allowed in the back garden at any one time to ensure the safety of the children.

Can you make sure your child has spare clothes in their bags please, due to the nice weather the children have been enjoying water play in the garden. If you wish you can pop in their swimming costumes/trunks and t-shirt to get changed into.

When dropping off or collecting your child, you can use the drive. Please do not park across the drive as this prevents other cars from using it. If anyone else is collecting your child, please inform them not to park across the drive way entrance and exit. If you don't wish to use the drive, there is space for 2 cars at the front or spaces to the left next to Bobby's Wood. Thank you.

Just a little reminder to not to let other parents into the building when entering and leaving, to keep everyone safe, every parent needs to buzz at the door and wait to be let in. Please make sure when shutting the door, you do so with lifting the handle up to ensure the door is closed properly, this is for the safety of all the children. Thank you
