Can parents/careers please label your children's belongings, as some may get mixed up and we can give them back to the right owner.

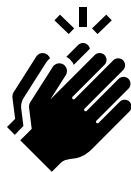

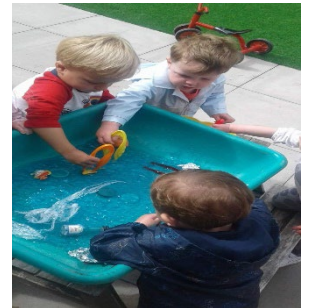


The Baby Bees have enjoyed creating their own Father's Day cards and chocolate gifts. We hope all of our parents/carers enjoyed them!
