All new children, please can you email over a few family photographs for our family album if you have not already.



Honey Bees have also created their own lion pictures, using different types of pasta and coloured card for World Lion Day.














This month Bizzy Bees have been helping our school leavers, using activities to promote their maths skills, learning about hot and cold, recognising numbers and letter formation.
