From September Bizzy Bees will begin working on their new topic All About Me by taking part in activities and learning new things about themselves and their peers.

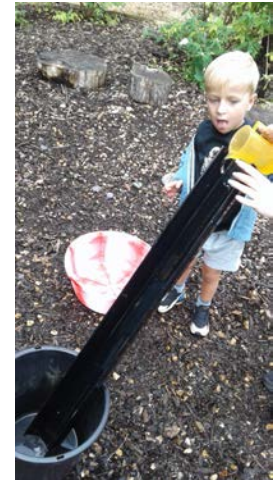

All the children have enjoyed taking part in lots of fun outdoor activities.

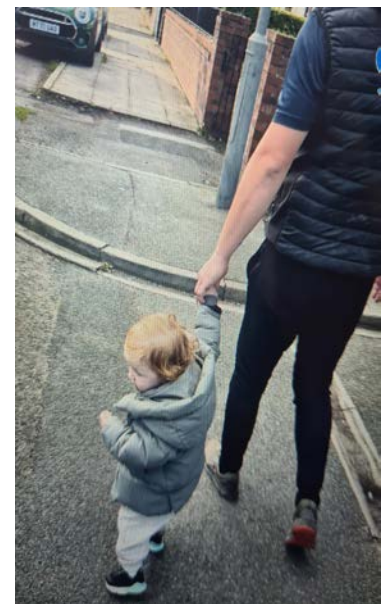


🌱 🧑🌾 Eco School Update 🧑🌾 🌱
