Baby Bees

Baby Bees have really enjoyed learning new nursery rhymes. The children loved getting wet in the water while singing 'Row, Row, Row, Your Boat' and creating their own boats using paint.

The staff have been teaching the children how to scoop and pour the water using their fine motor skills. The children have also been interested in looking at the textured books, they have explored all the different textures.

The children have loved popping all the bubbles with our new bubble machine.

Honey Bees

Honey Bees have enjoyed reading lots of different stories new and old using lots of props. The children have enjoyed developing their skill to recite the stories that they love. They are able to tell you what happens in books like 'The Gruffalo' and 'The Hungry Caterpillar'. The children really enjoyed making their own potions in cauldrons when learning about 'Room on the Broom', they particularly enjoyed mixing the ingredients together and watching it bubble. The children made their own tea party for 'The Tiger Who Came for Tea', with Tiger food.



Bizzy Bees



Bizzy Bees have enjoyed learning all about Space and they can name all the different planets in the Solar System, in order. The children have made their own planets using paper mache and paint.

The children have really enjoyed learning the planet song which they love singing. The children have enjoyed exploring the Moon Sand and making their own equators.

The children have been learning how to make different shapes. We used the children's bodies to make some simple shapes on the floor. They made a triangle, circle and square.

Parents Notice & Reminders
