Baby Bees have been focusing on activities to learn body parts and single words, such as naming and mirror games, songs and rhymes and role play with dolls. They have also been learning how to follow instructions such as “Wash the doll’s face”.

We celebrated Mental Health Week by turning our room into a Spa where the children enjoyed relaxing hands and feet massages and by taking part in yoga sessions, during which the children were able to copy actions, follow instructions and develop motor skills.
