Room News



Baby Bees

Baby Bees have been focusing on sensory exploration engaging in Under the Sea themed activities.

The children have been exploring colours, textures and smells during messy play, such as a Pirate themed tuff tray, making their own coral reef using play doh and painting with sand.

Baby Bees also enjoyed celebrating the Olympics by taking part in lots of outdoor physical activities.



Honey Bees

The children have been learning to recognise different objects by matching pictures.

They also enjoyed learning about the different textures and colours of different animals and using their hands to explore the textures of the animals who came to visit us.



Bizzy Bees

Over the last few weeks, Bizzy Bees have really enjoyed looking after our Butterflies, watching them grow and change from Caterpillars into beautiful Butterflies.

Bizzy Bees have also enjoyed some time in the sun with a visit from the Ice Cream Van and meeting and exploring all the different animals outdoors in the garden, such as Rabbits, Snakes, Lizards, Turtles and an Owl.



Communication and Language Building

This month's Speech and Language focus emphasises the importance of modelling language for young children.

Children aged three to five typically learn four to six new words per day. By age three, most children can say around 300 words, and by age five, they will know and use up to 2,500 words.

Children learn through imitation, and modelling involves demonstrating language. If your child isn't using words yet, interpret their attempts to communicate and say the word for them to hear. This approach helps your child associate words with objects or actions. Repetition is key for building confidence and reinforcing the brain connections that support language learning.
