Staff Recognition *****



She is such an essential part of our team, and we are incredibly lucky to have her.










Baby Bees

No Food Items


 Please do not bring food items into the setting or leave food in your child's bag. This is crucial due to the presence of allergies among children.

 The use of mobile phones is not permitted inside the building, including phone calls or browsing while in the hallway. This policy helps us maintain a safe and focused environment for the children.

Session Times

- If your child attends a morning session, they must be collected by 1:00 PM.
- If attending an afternoon session, please do not arrive before 1:00 PM.











Bag Checks

Please check your child's bag before coming to nursery. Bags should not contain any items that could pose a choking hazard or any form of medication or creams, unless pre-arranged with staff.

🔓 Gate Safety

 For everyone's safety, please ensure the gates on the stairs are locked securely behind you when entering or leaving the building.

Respectful Conduct

• We expect all individuals on the premises to behave in a respectful and courteous manner. Aggressive, abusive, or inappropriate behaviour or language towards staff, children, or other parents will not be tolerated.

Important Reminder

Can all parents/carers please ensure that you reconfirm your child's funding code/information on the GOV.UK portal every 3 months.

This is essential to ensure continued access to funded childcare. Failure to reconfirm may result in a temporary loss of your child's funded hours.
