



Outdoor Learning

The camp site has been a big hit with the children this month, offering endless opportunities for learning through discussion and story telling- thinking about all the amazing adventures they could have. From making aeroplanes and boarding passes to sharing a story and song time around the camp fire, the children have been developing key skills such as hand-eye coordination, fine-motor skills to problem-solving, and early mathematical concepts like ordering numbers to matching the socks on the washing line.

The tuff-tray and mud kitchen also sparks language development, as children describe what they see, feel, and do—building vocabulary through sensory experiences. Whether it's lemon and lime scented trays with extensive vocabulary or the mud kitchen making recipes using lots of natural resources. The children loved the time outdoors and played collaboratively and had great fun in the sun!

No Food Items


Please do not bring food items into the setting or leave food in your child's bag. This is crucial due to the presence of allergies among children.
