To celebrate National Ice Cream Day, the children had a fantastic day of sensory exploration and imaginative play. They went on a fun trip to the shop, where they each selected their own ice

This activity encouraged them to think about their own facial features and express themselves through art and imaginative play. The children also explored creative painting techniques by



learning how to blow through straws to move paint across the paper. This exciting and colourful activity not only sparked their creativity but also supported their oral motor development and breath control. It was a fantastic way to introduce a new skill in a playful and engaging environment!

environment. It was a fun, educational experience that encouraged us to bring new eco-friendly ideas back to nursery and continue making positive changes in our daily routines.




<u> Parents Notice & Reminders 📢</u>

Collection Time

All children must be collected by 5:45 PM. This ensures staff have enough time to give you a full handover and to clean and tidy the rooms before finishing for the day.

No Food Items

Please do not bring food items into the setting or leave food in your child's bag. This is crucial due to the











presence of allergies among children.

Mobile Phone Use

• The use of mobile phones is not permitted inside the building, including phone calls or browsing while in the hallway. This policy helps us maintain a safe and focused environment for the children.

Session Times

- If your child attends a morning session, they must be collected by 1:00 PM.
- If attending an afternoon session, please do not arrive before 1:00 PM.

Bag Checks

• Please check your child's bag before coming to nursery. Bags should not contain any items that could pose a choking hazard or any form of medication or creams, unless pre-arranged with staff.

Gate Safety

• For everyone's safety, please ensure the gates on the stairs are locked securely behind you when entering or leaving the building.

Respectful Conduct

 We expect all individuals on the premises to behave in a respectful and courteous manner. Aggressive, abusive, or inappropriate behaviour or language towards staff, children, or other parents will not be tolerated.

• We regularly review our policies to ensure they reflect the latest guidance. You'll have received a copy upon registration, but please speak to the setting manager if you'd like the most up-to-date version.

Important Reminder

Can all parents/carers please ensure that you reconfirm your child's funding code/information on the GOV.UK portal every 3 months.

This is essential to ensure continued access to funded childcare. Failure to reconfirm may result in a temporary loss of your child's funded hours.
