Beep beep! Off we go! 🚌 💥 🚜



We love seeing the children so engaged in active learning — indoors and out — and we're excited for even more exploration in the weeks to come!












Eco-Schools

Staff Information - Meet Alfie!




We're thrilled to share some wonderful news — the newest (and certainly the cutest!) member of our team has arrived!

Important Reminders for Parents/Carers



To help us maintain a safe, well-organised, and supportive environment for all children, we kindly ask that you take note of the following important reminders:



Mobile Phone Use

Mobile phones must not be used inside the building, including making calls or scrolling in the hallway. This is part of our commitment to safeguarding all children.

Funding Code Reconfirmation

Please ensure you reconfirm your child's funding code/information on the GOV.UK portal every 3 months. This is necessary to continue receiving funded childcare. Missing a reconfirmation could result in a temporary loss of your child's funded hours.

Car Park Safety

If you are using the car park, please drive slowly and carefully. We have noticed several cars entering and exiting at high speed, which poses a safety risk to children and families.

Restocking Bags

Please ensure your child's bag is restocked regularly with nappies and wipes as needed.

Bag Checks

Before coming to nursery, check your child's bag to ensure it does not contain any choking hazards, medications, or creams, unless previously discussed with staff.

Sun Protection

With the warmer weather approaching, please remember to bring in a sun hat for your child to ensure they are protected while playing outdoors. As water play activities increase with warmer weather, please pack extra clothes for your child each day.

Front Door Security

For safeguarding reasons, please do not let other parents in or hold the main door open when dropping off or collecting your child. It is important that we know who is entering/leaving the building at all times.

Policies

We regularly review our policies to ensure they reflect the latest guidance. You'll have received a copy upon registration, but please speak to the setting manager if you'd like the most up-to-date version.

Safeguarding Information

You and your child/children are very important to us. If we suspect any form of harm we will take action to help by making a referral to protect you or your child.

If you do have any safeguarding concerns or would like any information please feel free to speak to a member of management.
